and
Registered Part Bred/Over height Connemara Dressage Competition**

All classes are open to registered pure bred mountain and moorland ponies and registered part-bred/over height Connemara ponies. A pony can only compete at two levels and can only enter one section per class.

Each class will have three sections comprising of the following:-

- a) Junior section for riders under 16.
- b) Registered Part bred/over height Connemara pony.
- c) Registered pure bred mountain and moorland pony.

Class 3 and **class 5** will incorporate **BCPS Dressage Qualifiers** where the first and second highest placed Connemara in section C will qualify for the final at the BCPS Breed Show at Moreton Morell on Saturday 21st July 2012. Competitors on Connemara/Part-bred ponies can enter the qualifier without being a member of the BCPS however would have to join if they wish to compete at the final. The part bred/ over height section in **class 3** and **class 5** will also incorporate part bred/over height qualifiers. Competitors may enter both the Prelim and Novice qualifying rounds, but at the finals, the classes will be divided into Restricted (not to have been placed 1st-3rd at the level above) and Open (all).

Non- BCPS members entry fee £12.00 per class, BCPS member entry fee £10.00 per class.

Closing date strictly Monday 26th March 2012 by 12pm.

Times will only be available on Friday 6th April on 01875 833341, between 4pm and 7pm.

1. To be judged under British Dressage Rules except where otherwise stated.
2. All competitors must compete within the correct grading level according to BD rules.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
4. Withdrawals as soon as possible please. Before closing date full refund but no refund after closing date.
5. No competitor to ride more than two horses per class.
6. Prizes to 6th place in each section.
7. Any complaints to be submitted, in writing, within 30 minutes of results, with a £10 deposit.
8. Light coloured gloves must be worn.
9. Riders compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken by the organisers, or the venue, for injuries or damage to horses, riders, spectators or vehicles.
10. All riders should ensure they have 3rd party insurance.
