ANY ABUSIVE LANGUAGE or BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS SHOW OFFICIALS, ANIMALS or FELLOW COMPETITORS WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE SHOWGROUND and by entering this Show you agree to abide by this and all of the following:

1. All persons entering the showground must have personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Show will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under NO Circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and grooms enter the show rings.
2. The Judges' decision is final. Any objections must be made, in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.
3. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
4. The Committee reserve the right to alter judges if required.
5. The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made either by post or on the day.
6. Under NO circumstances will entries be substituted and any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
7. In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date unconditionally.
8. In the event of cancellation, refunds MUST be requested in writing (NO emails) and should be sent with a SAE enclosed to the Show Organisers within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £10 admin charge.
9. Mountain and Moorland ponies will be shown in accordance to the Breed Society rules.
10. In-foal mares may be asked to produce a certificate of service. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown, all foals must be a minimum of three weeks old.
11. Stallions may not be led or ridden by children under the age of 12 years in accordance with NPS rules and must be licensed in accordance with breed society rules.
12. All trophies will remain the property of the show and must be signed for. They will be held for the remainder of the year and must be returned to the show upon request.
13. In the interest of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring will not be tolerated.
14. The Show Organisers reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
15. Dishonoured cheques will incur a £10 administrative fee and may result in entries being refused in the future.
16. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Any dog caught off the lead will result in a £10 fine.
17. Please use the bins provided for litter and no mucking out of horseboxes onto the show field.
18. No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought into the Showground.
19. There will be no holding of any classes; competitors enter multiple classes at their own risk.
20. This show is open to registered M&M Native Ponies.

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 3 Fell Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 4 Fell Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Fell Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Dales Ponies In-hand – Judge – Mrs J James

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 5 Dales Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 6 Dales Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Dales Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Exmoor Ponies In-hand – Judge – Mrs A Nicholls

New Forest Ponies In-hand – Judge – Miss N Stephens

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 13 New Forest Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 14 New Forest Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

New Forest Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Connemara Ponies In-hand – Judge – Mrs A Nicholls

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 15 Connemara Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 16 Connemara Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Connemara Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Class 17 Welsh Section A or B Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 18 Welsh Section A or B Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Welsh Section A or B Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Welsh Section C & D In-hand – Judge – Mr R Hunt

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 19 Welsh Section C or D Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 20 Welsh Section C or D Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Welsh Section C or D Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Home Produced In-hand Section – Judge – Mrs J James

Open to registered pure bred M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY Basis or at stud. To be owned/kept, produced, ridden/handled by a person who does not receive remuneration in cash or in kind from working with horses/ponies. No professional producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse/pony.

Please enter this class in the spirit in which it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

Class 21 Small Breeds Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

Class 53 Open First Ridden

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 54 Novice Lead Rein

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Pony never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in Leading Rein Classes.

Class 55 Novice First Ridden

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in First Ridden Classes.

Mini Ridden Championship (1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes will compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to The Supreme M&M Ridden Championship.

WHP SECTION

Novice WHP Championship (1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes will compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to The Supreme M&M WHP Championship.

Intermediate Working Hunter Pony Section– Judge – Miss N Stephens (jumping) & Mr R James (conformation)

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit. A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has qualified for the WHP final at Horse of the Year Show or RI.

Class 60 Ponies not exceeding 122cm

Class 61 Ponies exceeding 122cm but not exceeding 133cm

Class 62 Ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 143cm

Class 63 Ponies exceeding 143cm but not exceeding 148cm (except for Dales and Welsh Section D for which there is no height restriction.)

Intermediate WHP Championship (1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes will compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to The Supreme M&M WHP Championship.

Open Working Hunter Pony Section – Judge – Miss N Stephens (jumping) & Miss D Spears (conformation)

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, five years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

Class 64 Ponies not exceeding 122cm

Class 65 Ponies exceeding 122cm but not exceeding 133cm

Class 66 Ponies exceeding 133cm but not exceeding 143cm

Class 67 Ponies exceeding 143cm but not exceeding 148cm (except for Dales and Welsh Section D for which there is no height restriction.)

Open WHP Championship (1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes will compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to The Supreme M&M WHP Championship.

Junior Working Hunter Pony Section – Judge – Mrs M Brimson (jumping) & Miss J Paterson (conformation)

Open to registered pure bred M&M stallions, mares and geldings, four years old or over. Riders may only ride one pony in each class.

- Class 68** Ponies not exceeding 128cm. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
