ANY ABUSIVE LANGUAGE or BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS SHOW OFFICIALS, ANIMALS or FELLOW COMPETITORS WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE SHOWGROUND and by entering this Show you agree to abide by this and all of the following:

1. All persons entering the showground must have personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Show will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under NO Circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and grooms enter the show rings.
2. The Judges' decision is final. Any objections must be made, in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.
3. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
4. The Committee reserve the right to alter judges if required.
5. The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made either by post or on the day.
6. Under NO circumstances will entries be substituted and any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
7. In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date unconditionally.
8. In the event of cancellation, refunds MUST be requested in writing (NO emails) and should be sent with a SAE enclosed to the Show Organisers within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £10 admin charge.
9. Mountain and Moorland ponies will be shown in accordance to the Breed Society rules.
10. In-foal mares may be asked to produce a certificate of service. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown, all foals must be a minimum of three weeks old.
11. Stallions may not be led or ridden by children under the age of 12 years in accordance with NPS rules and must be licensed in accordance with breed society rules.
12. All trophies will remain the property of the show and must be signed for. They will be held for the remainder of the year and must be returned to the show upon request.
13. In the interest of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring will not be tolerated.
14. The Show Organisers reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
15. Dishonoured cheques will incur a £10 administrative fee and may result in entries being refused in the future.
16. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Any dog caught off the lead will result in a £10 fine.
17. Please use the bins provided for litter and no mucking out of horseboxes onto the show field.
18. No animal suffering from a contagious disease may be brought into the Showground.
19. There will be no holding of any classes; competitors enter multiple classes at their own risk.
20. This show is open to registered M&M Native Ponies.

New Forest Ponies In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Shetland Ponies In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 10 Shetland Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Shetland Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Dartmoor Ponies In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 11 Dartmoor Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 12 Dartmoor Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Dartmoor Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Dales Ponies In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 13 Dales Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 14 Dales Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Dales Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Exmoor Ponies In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 15 Exmoor Pony Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Class 16 Exmoor Pony Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Exmoor Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

The Native Pony Show 2019- SCHEDULE

Home Produced In-hand Section –

Open to registered pure bred M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY Basis or at stud. To be owned/kept, produced, ridden/handled by a person who does not receive remuneration in cash or in kind from working with horses/ponies. No professional producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse/pony.

Please enter this class in the spirit in which it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

Class 17 Small Breeds Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Class 18 Small Breeds Colt, Filly or Gelding 3 years old and under

Welsh Section C & D In-hand –

These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies in the main body of their studbook. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive any qualifications. Foals are not eligible.

Class 24 Welsh Section C or D Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over

Welsh Section C or D Pony In-hand Championship (1st & 2nd Prize winners from the above classes to compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme In-Hand Championship.

Veteran Section –

Open to registered pure bred M&M ponies 15 years and over. All horses and ponies must be in a sound healthy condition.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year it has qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship final at Horse of the Year Show, Royal International Horse Show or Olympia.

Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

Class 49 Open First Ridden

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 50 Novice Lead Rein

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years or over not exceeding 122cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Pony never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in Leading Rein Classes.

Class 51 Novice First Ridden

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in First Ridden Classes.

Mini Ridden Championship (1st and 2nd prize winners from the above classes will compete.) Champion and Reserve Champion will then go forward to Native Pony Show Supreme Ridden Championship.

Junior Ridden Section

Open to pure bred registered M&M stallions, mares and geldings four years or over.
